BY_LAWS:

- **Membership** –Must be a member of the VFW or the Auxiliary in good standing to be eligible.
- **Rules and Behavior**- All by-laws from the VFW riders as well as the original Post by-laws will be followed and adhered to.
- **Colors** -Colors are the property of the club. These colors are to be worn properly and respected. Individuals who bring disrespect and disgrace to these colors will be asked to forfeit their colors back to the club. This will be done by a 2/3 majority vote. There are no refunds. The fees that you paid are for the privilege to wear these colors.
- **Patches**- You cannot wear any Military service awards or patches unless you have earned them. Military patches that have not been earned, but are being worn in honor of someone who has served will be allowed as long as this patch specifies the purpose for which it is being displayed. If you have a vest or jacket that have our colors displayed, it is strongly recommended that there not be any patches that contain derogatory or harsh profanity.
- **Meetings**- All members are encouraged to attend meetings. This includes Board meeting. All board meetings are open to any member.
- **Rides**- All bikes must be in good running condition. All rides will start and end at the VFW. Some exceptions might arise; these will be dealt with on a case by case basis. Once the ride has started, you will maintain your formation position. If you desire to change positions you must wait until the next stop. Excessive drinking during VFW rides will not be tolerated. If by chance a rider breaks down, you need not worry, you will be taken care of.
- **Officers**- These positions will be a one year term, with the exception of the first acting officers. These will be a two year term for the sole purpose of getting established organization up and maintained. Any member can run for any officer's position. The only exception is President, this position can only be held by a veteran (Combat or Non Combat, both are eligible).
